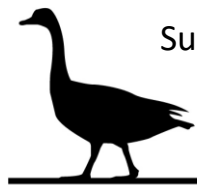
(OUTSIDE VENDORS, please note the width and depth if you'll be selling from a trailer or vehicle.)

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VENDOR INFORMATION – TERMS & CONDITIONS

SHOW DATE & TIME — Sunday, **September 6, 2026** – 11 AM to 4 PM – at the Fair Grounds in **BOISSEVAIN, MB**

SET UP

All indoor and outdoor spaces are assigned and arranged at the discretion of the coordinator. Every effort will be made to accommodate special requests, but they can't be guaranteed. Arrangement of goods and tables is at each vendor's discretion but must remain within the marked boundary of the space.

There is a limit of two (2) vendor gate passes per registration.

Vendor set up will be from **12 noon** until **7 PM** on **Saturday, September 5, 2026** with limited drive-in access. We ask that vendors **UNLOAD QUICKLY AND THEN PARK VEHICLES IN THE VENDOR PARKING AREA BEFORE UNPACKING**. The indoor spaces (arena and curling club) will be open again at **8 AM** on **Sunday, September 6, 2026** for vendors to finish setting up. Vendors should be ready for opening no later than 10:30 AM on Sunday.

MERCHANDISE & DISPLAY

We are committed to producing an attractive antique and collectible show and flea market and ask that each vendor help by keeping their booth clean, tidy, and interesting to the eye. We also ask that you cover your display overnight and when it is unattended. The event promoter reserves the right to restrict the display of any item deemed unsuitable.

LIABILITY & INSURANCE

Each vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Organizers (Boissevain Kinsmen Club and Boissevain Kinette Club), the Venues (Municipality of Boissevain-Morton, Turtle Mountain Ag Society, and Boissevain Curling Club), and their employees, agents, and volunteers from any claims of loss, damage, or injury to persons or property caused by the vendor (or his/her employees or agents) through any wrongful act, neglect, or default. The Organizers and the Venues and their employees, agents and volunteers shall not be held liable to the vendor (or his/her employees, agents, or customers) for any personal injury or damage to property. All items brought to the Dunrea Flea Market by the vendor (or his/her employees, agents, or customers) shall be entered at the vendor's own risk for any loss or damage.

PAYMENT & CANCELLATION POLICY

There will be **NO REFUNDS**. Payments may be made by cash, cheque, or e-transfer (e-transfer address: info@drfm.ca). There is a \$40.00 charge for all N.S.F. cheques.

RETURNING VENDORS: To the extent possible the Dunrea Flea Market will offer existing vendors the same (or an equivalent) space if they pay in full for space, tables, and extras by **March 31, 2026**.

The organizers will not confirm any booking until all registration fees are paid, and unpaid space may be re-assigned.

TAKE DOWN

Vendors are asked not to start packing any merchandise until the show ends at 4 PM on Sunday, September 6. The indoor spaces (arena and curling club) must be vacated by 7 PM.
